When do we have Licensing Classes?

- Weekdays (Monday 8am-5pm & Tuesday 8am-3pm)
- Weekends (Saturday 8am-5pm & Sunday 8am-3pm)

How much do PA state courses cost?

•

- The course is **FREE** to **PA Residents**
 - This includes the following classes: 2WBRC, 3WBRC, BRC2-SP (Non-Licensing)

What will I need to register for a class?

- Current/Valid motorcycle permit
- Valid Driver's License (Already have class M, and looking for training)

How many people are in a licensing class?

• Maximum of 12 students

What kind of motorcycle will I be riding?

- Harley-Davidson[®] Street 500 (2-wheel)
- KTM Duke 200 or 390 (2-wheel)
- Can-Am Ryker (3-wheel)
- Can-Am Spyder F3 (3-wheel)

What do I need to bring with me to class?

- 1. Your Learner's Permit / or Drivers License (for those with Class M) (Need Every day!)
- 2. A copy of your E-Course completion certificate (print certificate or have a clear picture of it on your phone. The instructor will collect first day)
- 3. Appropriate riding gear (See STEP 3 on website)

What do I need to do to earn my motorcycle endorsement?

- You must attend the entire 16-hour course, 2 consecutive days.
- You must come to class with all the required safety gear, complete the MSF 5hr online E-Course, and pass the riding evaluation at the end of the range session. After all has been successfully passed you will receive course Class M endorsement. (Note: if you take 3-wheel you will be limited to only allowed 3-wheels on the rode)

Do we get breaks?

• Yes. Your instructors will give you adequate breaks including a lunch break. Consider packing a lunch.

What if I need to reschedule or cancel?
